For 20 years Bridge of Life has been guided by a simple but profound belief: everyone, everywhere deserves the chance to live a healthy and fulfilling life. Access to care should strengthen families and communities, not separate them.

As I reflect on 2025, I am incredibly proud of how our Village has rallied together to turn this belief into action. This year's report is a testament to what we can achieve when we unite to strengthen healthcare locally and around the world. Together, we screened over 5,000 individuals for chronic kidney disease and its root causes, ensuring that 100% of high-risk patients were connected to ongoing support. We also continued to build sustainable healthcare capacity globally training over 300 clinicians and technicians across nine countries and expanding access to life-saving treatments in three additional underserved communities.

Behind every number is a story of hope and resilience. These milestones are only possible because of **you**. Whether you are a dedicated volunteer, a generous donor, one of the hundreds of teammates who raise funds and gather supplies, your unwavering support fuels our mission.

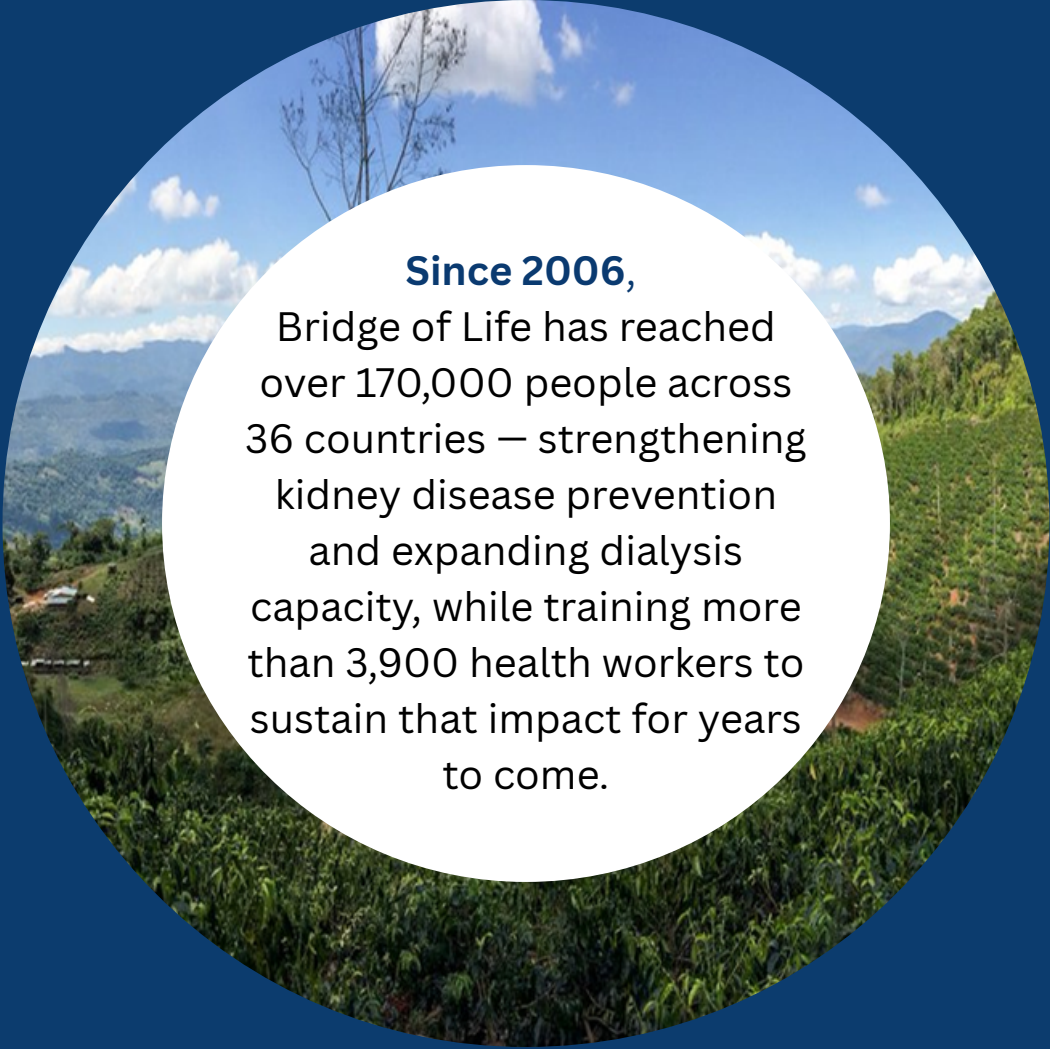

CKD Prevention in Nepal

DaVita teammates carried their commitment to CKD prevention beyond borders by partnering with Bridge of Life.

Six DaVita volunteers worked alongside local clinicians and the Nepal Kidney Foundation at public health posts, screening 947 people, many of whom traveled hours just for the chance to learn about their health. Together, we delivered screenings, health education, and referrals...building bridges between communities and the care everyone deserves.

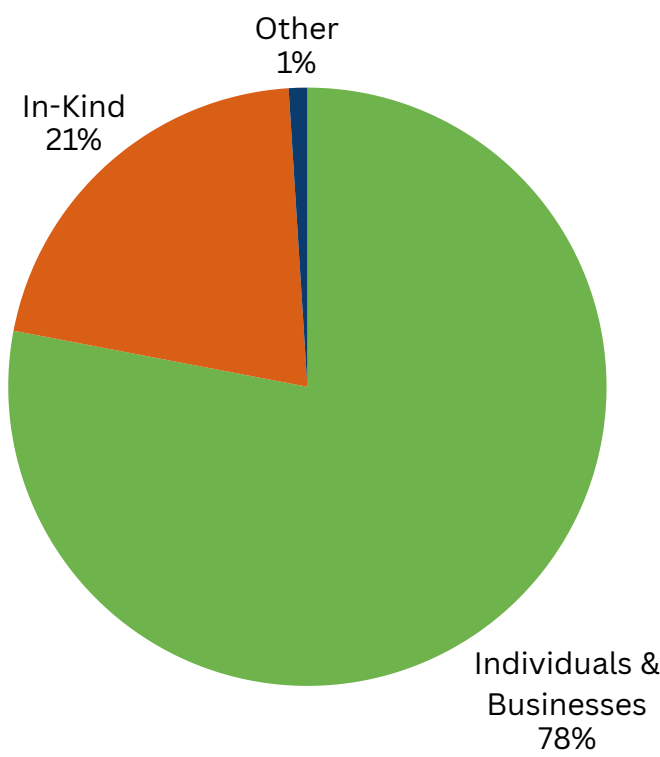

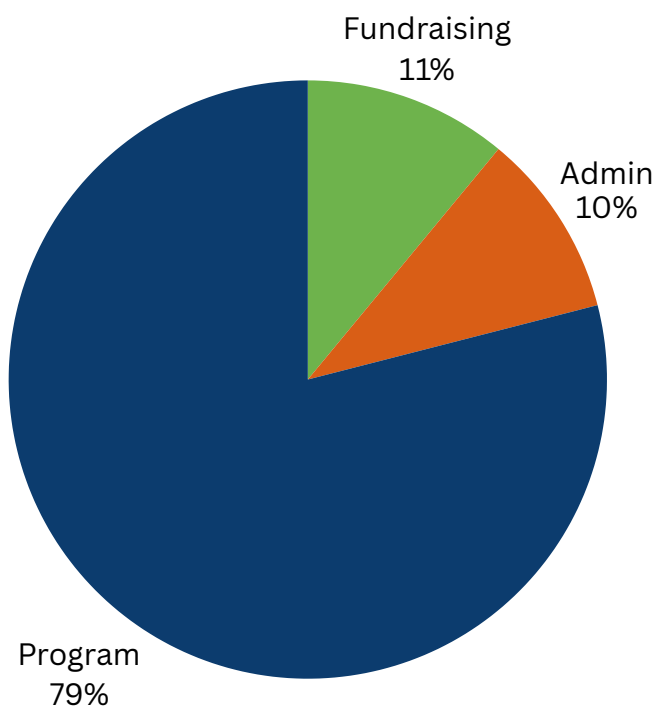


FINANCIAL IMPACT
